We ship from **five deep-water export terminals** across the U.S. Southeast.



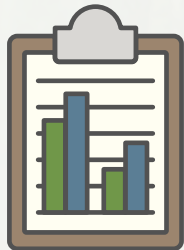
We have **five corporate offices** in key markets around the world.
